GLENBURGIE 10 YEARS OLD 40%

In partnership with each respective distillery, all whiskies in our Distillery Labels range are uniquely labelled. In years gone by many of these unique designs were used 'officially' to bottle the whisky under license from the distillery. Today these trusted relationships with distillers enables Gordon & MacPhail to bottle whiskies at various ages, strengths and vintages - all with their unique distillery label.

Set close to the A96, near the village of Alves, lies Glenburgie Distillery which looks over the Moray Firth. The distillery was originally called Kilnflat, although in 1878 after a period of disuse, it was renamed Glenburgie. Nearby is Burgie Castle, which dates back to the 16th century.

For a short while Glenburgie also produced another single malt, Glenraig. This was produced using Lomond stills and is available in our Connoisseurs Choice range.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: Golden brown.

WITHOUT WATER:

Nose: Fruity with hints of citrus and mulled fruit, with sweet, creamy elements. Touch of toasted malt.

Palate: Rich fruit with sweet, oaky notes, some pepperiness with floral hints.

WITH WATER:

Nose: Fruit - grapefruit skins with toffee fudge aromas.

Palate: Sherry notes with sweet, toffee flavours.

Body: Medium, complex.

Finish: Short.

Cask Type(s): First fill Sherry butts and Sherry hogsheads.

Whisky Style: A lesser-known Speysider full of character, subtle Sherry influence.



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
